Encountering Christ

As a priest, I'm amazed how happily married couples remember the tiniest details of their earliest encounters. They effortlessly report things like: "he wore a blue shirt," "we ordered brussels sprouts," "her hair was up in a bun," and "he spilled shrimp cocktail sauce at my family's open front door when it was ten degrees below zero," (that one's courtesy of my mom). We delight in remembering and speaking of when our new life of love began. The little details are glorious reminders that it's all *real*.

It's similar for John the Apostle. He tells us of the two disciples who followed Jesus into His house, "**...they stayed with Him that day. It was about four o'clock in the afternoon.**" Why does that tiny detail matter? *That's the time of day when they encountered the love of Jesus, the Messiah, in their lives.* Our religion is not primarily about abstract truths about God, no matter how true or sublime. It is about God meeting and saving us in our human nature. It's about a *human* relationship.

What was the time of day when you first recall encountering Christ and His Church? Who was there? What did you feel? How did things look and smell? What happened? Take some time to recall it in detail. For me, it was inside an old, rickety church on a hillside in Jerome, Arizona. It was about 9 p.m. on a Saturday evening. I was with my friends Jenny, Brad, and Laura. We were praying, singing, and laughing. When was it for you?

Remembering the details isn't empty nostalgia. It reminds us now that God's love for us in our humanity is real.

Update in worship practices from Bishop Michael Barber: Kneeling During Mass



The General Instruction for the Roman Missal for the United States, No 43, states that "In the dioceses of the United States of America, they should kneel beginning after the singing or recitation of the *Sanctus* (*Holy, Holy, Holy*) until after the *Amen* of the Eucharistic Prayer, except when prevented on occasion by ill health, or for reasons of lack of space, of the large number of people present, or for another reasonable cause The faithful kneel after the *Agnus Dei* (*Lamb of God*); unless the Diocesan Bishop determines otherwise."

I understand it had been the policy in our diocese set by a previous bishop to remain standing following the Lamb of God. However, I see no valid reason for us to diverge from the common practice of the Church in the United States.

Therefore, I ask that in our diocese we join the rest of the faithful in our country in kneeling after the Lamb of God in order to prepare ourselves reverently for reception of Holy Communion.

Following reception of Holy Communion, each person may stand, sit or kneel as they choose, until the priest asks everyone to stand for the *Prayer After Communion*.

These policies are to be considered Normative and must be observed by Ash Wednesday, February 14, 2024.

Our Winter Bible Study Revelation: The Kingdom Yet to Come

During our recent studies about the Eucharist, the Book of Revelation was referenced so often that we decided we need to delve into this fascinating and misunderstood book of the Bible.

Perhaps no book of the Bible fascinates, intimidates or confuses people more than Revelation. Yet relatively few people have studied it, especially from a Catholic perspective.

Revelation: The Kingdom Yet to Come is an intriguing eleven-session study program that shows how the Kingdom established by Christ in His Church is intimately connected with the Kingdom of Heaven. In this study, we will pull back the veil on the rich symbolism present in Revelation, discover what the mysterious figures and images of Revelation mean, see how Revelation is more than an apocalyptic vision of the “end times” and explore the Church’s teaching on the second coming of Christ and the Last Judgment. Understand how God, the Divine Bridegroom, and the Church, his spotless bride, enter into a heavenly, holy, and mystical marriage every time we celebrate Mass.

In fact, after this study, you will understand why the Book of Revelation may very well be the easiest book of the Bible to understand.

Alpha gives you (and your guests) an opportunity to encounter Jesus in a life-changing way ... and to be empowered to play a part in each other's journeys.

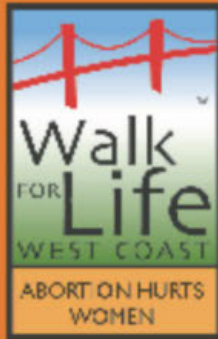

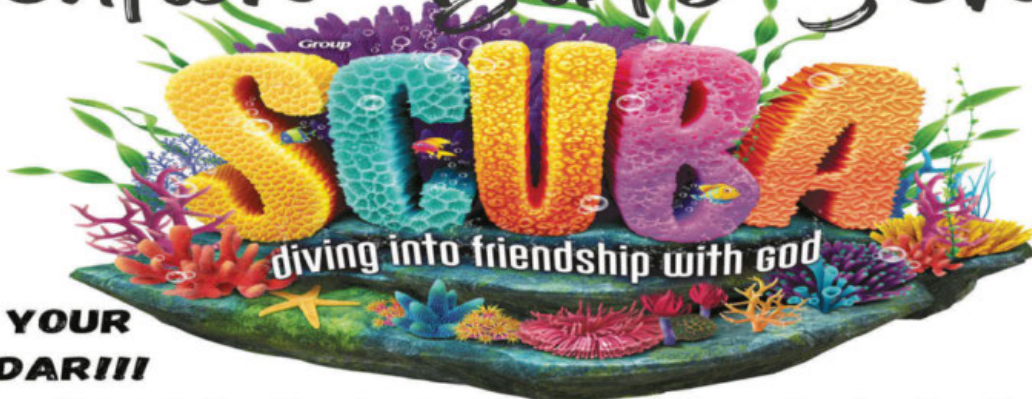
